Preparing images for uploading, please adhere to the following file specifications:

- sRGB or RGB color space (standard) NOT CMYK (typically used by printing industry)
- save files to 72 ppi resolution; flatten layers, 8 bit JPEG files (16 bit will not upload.)
- sized to 1,280 pixels on the longest side, the other size width or height proportional
- JPG format, compression level 7 (medium). Compression level will not affect the quality of viewed images.
- Use period preceding jpg in the file name. Characters (!@ $$\%^8$)_+)will result in uploading problems.
